Message from Dave, Council President

As we look ahead to the coming year, we have much to be thankful for.

In 2024, like many other years, our community came together in various ways living out Gods word through worship, service, in celebration and through supporting others - both locally and across the globe.

We served 34 families in our first year with Foster Together / Abundant Goods, our youth served the community in Niagara Falls for their summer Mission Trip, more than 50 kids attended youth programs, we welcomed 14 new members and celebrated 7 baptisms in 2024. Our community came together to freshen up our building, which continues to be a blessing for our community as home to the Montessori school, hosting blood drives, AA groups and in many other ways.

Our congregation continues to bless Family of Christ financially, participating in social events, and through volunteering. Over the past 5 years, Family of Christ has been able to operate within our means, managing expenses appropriately to build up our reserves and building funds to over \$110k, and this year we are on track for a budget surplus of \$10k thanks to the generosity of our congregation and effective management of expenses.

The financial blessings we have provide us with the opportunity to further support our Family of Christ staff and grow stronger connections with both our congregation and the broader community at large in 2025. In Mathew 25:14-30 the Parable of the Talents, Jesus teaches us that the gifts we are given should be used responsibly to grow God's Kingdom and not to hide our gifts where they cannot bear fruit.

With all that we have accomplished over the past years, there are many things left undone. Since the end of the Pastoral Intern program in 2023, we have felt the impact of losing that valuable resource. We have not been able to accomplish all that we set out to do in the community with outreach, deepening congregational connections and increasing our social presence to invite and welcome others to Family of Christ.

In our upcoming annual meeting, the council will bring forward a budget that includes a new part-time Project Manager position. This position will lead both day-to-day and longer-term projects to build congregational connections, establish volunteer teams, small groups and lead the update of our website and social presence to invite others to Family of Christ. This role will allow Pastor Brent to devote more time to ministry as we welcome more into our community.

With this position, we expect our 2025 operating budget to show a \$20k deficit. There is a clear path to funding this position by applying the \$10k surplus from 2024 and another \$10k from our reserves account. We believe that God has provided us with the gift to invest in growth and that the addition of this role will pay dividends back to our community in many ways - inviting and welcoming more from our community into Family of Christ.

I pray that you will support the 2025 budget and addition of this position. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me or attend our budget meeting on January 19th following Sunday service.


Volunteer Thanks
