March 16: It's Not the Destination, It's the Journey | Deuteronomy 32:1-10, 44-52

Sometimes we don't even make it there. And even when we do, the Promised Land is not the end of the journey. How can we let God reshape our vision of both the destination and the journey so that we can find beauty and meaning in all of it?
