

Below are a list of activities and service possibilities for the next three months. Please sign up for areas of interest in the Narthex, fellowship space, and service room.

Worship and Music

Worship Assistant

Help in leading worship. Includes reading prayers, creating liturgy, and helping with other worship related activities. Monthly meeting and serve each month.

Choir

Join with others in singing each month, no previous experience needed. Choir meets Sundays before worship at 8:30am and usually sings the 3rd Sunday of each month.

Logos Instrumental Based Worship Team

This group helps lead worship once a month with a variety of music and often more contemporary Christian music or arrangements. Both vocalists and instrumentalists welcome. Rehearse and lead worship once a month.

Special Music

Help enhance music by sharing special music during worship. Vocal soloists, instrumentalists, piano players and small groups. As arranged.

Actor

Help with short skits and opportunities during worship. No experience needed. Group would meet as opportunities come up. As needed.

Sacristan

Coordinate and care for worship supplies and other items needed for Sunday mornings. Clean and organize altar area and sacristy. Monthly.

Art

Create and/or organize art for worship space, fellowship area, and general church building. Can be any form of art. As needed.

Sharing My Story

Be willing to share your faith story as part of worship in either written statement or question and answer with worship leader. As arranged.

Acolyte

Assist worship by lighting and extinguishing candles, helping with children's sermon, and collecting noisy offering. Training will be provided. Once a month as assigned.



Love

Hospitality Team

Be part of the team that helps us create a comprehensive plan on how we can care for one another as a community and organize materials and volunteers on an ongoing basis. Meet quarterly.

Fellowship Host

Provide treats and make beverages for fellowship after worship on Sunday mornings. You will be partnered with another to share in this. Treats can be made or purchased. 1 to 2 times every 2 months.

Prayer Ministry

Support the community through prayer. Training will be provided. Pray on a regular basis from requests that come into the church. Ongoing prayers and quarterly meetings.

Make Meals

Provide meals to support families and/or make various dishes for community meals (Picnics, soup suppers, potlucks, funerals). Quarterly activities and meal making as needed.

Event Team

Help set-up, serve food, and/or clean-up after events such as community events and funerals. As needed.



Community Connection and Faith Growth

Community Women's Bible study

Come together with other women to study scriptures and grow in faith. Various commitments based on group. Meets 1st Monday at 10:00.

Men's Bible study

Come together with other men to study scriptures and grow in faith. Various commitments based on group. Current groups meet weekly Tuesday at 6:30 am and Thursdays at 8:00 am.

Book Club

Join with others to discuss various books as they pertain to faith and life. Monthly.

Soul Sisters

Ongoing women's ministry that connects women with one another through a variety of social options including teas, movie nights, and art opportunities. Regular events.

Theology Pub

Meet together at a local restaurant to discuss faith and current events. Monthly.

Dinner Groups

Meet with other families and individuals for a time of food a fellowship. These could be meals made and shared or going to restaurants. Meet quarterly.

Adult Education

Various opportunities after church and during the week throughout the year to learn more about faith and community topics. Meets throughout the year.

Community Events

Be a part of monthly events that help us connect with one another through socialization and service. Events monthly.

Outreach

Outreach Team Member

Be part of the team that helps us create a comprehensive plan on how we can care for those that live in the world around us and how we can make an impact in God's name. Meet monthly.

Welcome Team Member

Help greet and welcome people as they visit and/or seek to become part of the Family of Christ community. Yearly training and ongoing informal opportunities.



Servant Event Planner

Organize and help prepare for service events that make an impact throughout the community. As needed.

New Member Connector

Help integrate new and potential members into the community through a brunch and connecting through social situations. As needed.



Facilities

Fall and Spring Clean-up

Help keep facilities neat in appearance and do deeper cleaning. As needed.

General Maintenance and Upkeep

Help with regular maintenance of building or special projects that emerge throughout the year. As needed.

Electrical, Plumbing, Carpentry

Use special skills and abilities to care for our facilities in fixing or in new development. As needed.

Technology

Help with technical upkeep and plan for future community needs. As needed and yearly meeting.

Grounds Care

Help care for the exterior of facility through planting, weeding, and general exterior upkeep. 2 planned events and other opportunities.

Garden

Help plan and implement care for the community garden outreach program. Spring planning and periodically throughout the summer.

Painting

Paint and touch up walls in the building. Periodic opportunities with yearly community project.

Support Ministries

Counter

Count and record weekly offerings and gifts. Training will be provided. One time every other month.

Opener

Unlock building, turn on lights, and prepare building before worship approximately 8:00 am. 1-2 times every other month.

Closer

Lock building, turn off lights, and check building for any needs after worship and programming around 12:00pm. 1-2 times every other month.

Stewardship Team


Help identify gifts of time, talent, and treasure to support Family of Christ and help people grow in faith. Meet every other month and yearly to plan stewardship drive.

Communication Task Force

Help us evaluate current communication practices and make suggestions to better serve FOC and community around us. 3 meetings this fall.

CPR and AED Trained Volunteers

Help create a safe community by attending yearly training or identifying yourself as trained in CPR, First Aid, and AED use. Yearly training if needed or let us know you are trained.



Youth

Shepherd

Oversee a group of kids as they participate in an education station. Goal is to help as needed and provide connection and encouragement for Christian growth. Sign up when you are available.

Station Leader

Lead various themed lessons twice on a Sunday. Stations can include Art, Games, Active Storytelling, and Cooking. Sign up when you are available.

Supply Coordinator

Organize and/or purchase supplies needed for Sunday morning stations. This can be done anytime during the week. Sign up when you are available.

Help with Christmas Program

Help organize costumes, props, kids, and other needs for the Christmas program in December. Various commitments over 3 weeks of rehearsal depending on role.

Confirmation Mentor

Walk with our 7-9th grade youth as they learn about their own faith journey. Only need to have the desire to care for our youth. Monthly meeting in small group or in activity.

5-6 Grade teacher

Help educate our youth as they transition into middle school. All curriculum will be available. We are looking for several people to lead this together. Meets 2-3 times a month from 6:30-8:00.

Youth Team

Help plan and execute events and opportunities for our youth to grow in their faith and connect with one another. Meet monthly and participate in major events as assigned.
